

# GREATER ROCKFORD BASEBALL LEAGUE CONCESSION STAND INFORMATION

## Compensation for Scouts

The committee members of Troop 181 have laid out the compensation for all scouts working shifts at the concession stand. It is as follows:

- All scouts are expected to pick up at least one shift during the fundraiser.
- For each shift worked, the scout will earn 200 points. The first 200 will count towards the total points at the end of the year. Any additional points will be extras.
- Scouts will also be compensated in their Scout Account. At the end of the season, we will determine the Troop's total profit and each scout will receive a percent of the total profit based on the number of shifts worked.
- The schedule will be updated regularly on the website. When you choose a shift you would like to work, please email Sharon Quirke at [slquirke63@comcast.net](mailto:slquirke63@comcast.net) to reserve the time. Multiple shifts may be reserved based on availability. This is on a first come, first served basis.
- On Sunday, May 16<sup>th</sup>, any open shifts will be offered to groups outside of our Troop. Ideally, all shifts will be taken by our Scouts so the funds stay with the Troop. However, in an effort to ensure all shifts are staffed, we will go outside of the Troop.

## Attire

- Scouts should wear a Boy Scout activity t-shirt (class b). It can be any t-shirt that is scout related (Troop 181, summer camp, Cub Scout Pack, day camp, NYLT, Philmont, etc.).
- If parents have a Scout shirt, please wear yours as well.
- All staff must wear a hat per Health Department Regulations.
- Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- Please do not wear your field shirt (class a) tan BSA shirt.

## Miscellaneous Information

- Either Greg Poulisse or Sharon Quirke will be at the concession stand during set-up and clean up. We will take care of the money at the end of the shift as well.
- There is information posted that will guide you in knowing what your specific duties are during your work time.
- There is information posted that will guide you in using the equipment and how to make specific food items.

The most important thing to remember is to have a good time while you're there. We're hoping that this fundraiser will be a huge support for our Troop. One of the Committee's goals is to be able to replace some of the camping equipment that we need so much.
