Monday, August 6, 2007

- Be on time. “10 minutes early is on time, on time is late and late is unacceptable.”
- Park in the Boylan lot that everyone else is using, see map.
- Wear a T181 activity (formally class B) uniform shirt during evening hours and tell the ticket – takers at the entrance that you are a volunteer, you do not have to pay admission.
- Meet other T181 workers at the garage at the North end of the festival grounds so they can update you.
- We are there to empty the trash containers throughout the festival grounds.
- There is a dumpster on each side (East and West) of the grounds.
- Carry empty trash bags with you.
- Walk a circle through the grounds, checking on the status of trash cans. Split the grounds with your partner.
- When a trash can is full, pull the bag out and replace it. Carry the full bag to the nearest dumpster and throw it in. Sometimes you will want to combine half-full bags.
- Bring water to drink.

Notes on Morning Clean-Up Shifts

- All Scouts and parents are needed.
- Meet at the Fire Station at 8:00 AM or at Boylan at 8:30 AM. Boylan High School is located at 4000 Saint Francis Dr, Rockford, IL. Return to the fire station at around 10:30 AM depending on how much clean up is necessary and how many people are cleaning up. Monday will be around 12:30 PM.
- Clean up includes picking up all litter, including cigarette and cigar butts and consolidating trash bags.
- Bring gloves and leaf rakes, and if you have one a leaf vacuum for cigarette butts. The blowers do not work well, they create too much dust.
- Clean up area festival grounds, parking lots, the grass parking area, neighbor’s yards across the street, staff parking, and soccer field.
- **On Sunday, clean the stage and audience areas first. There is a Catholic Mass at 10:00 AM.**
