Medical Policies

All medical forms to Lois

- Campers under the age of 40 should use the Class 1 & 2 BSA Medical Form ([34414](#)).
- Campers over the age of 40 should use the Class 3 BSA Medical Form ([34412](#)).
- Every participant must provide a copy of their medical form to be kept on file after they leave Tesomas. Medical forms may be copied in the program center for 10¢ per copy.
- The above requirements are those of the State of Wisconsin and the Boy Scouts of America.
- Other physical forms may be used if they include the same information as the BSA forms.
- All medication must be turned in at medical checks (during the check-in process) to the Health Officer in the original prescription labeled container. To ensure a faster check-in have a Scout medication form already filled out for each scout taking medication.
- Inhalers, EpiPens, and other medications that are carried with the person do not have to be turned in but should be brought to medical checks.
- When surgical treatment or hospital care is needed for Samoset Council Scouts/Scouters, benefits in excess of \$300.00 will be paid only if they are unrecoverable from any other insurance policy or service contract. Therefore, it is imperative that you come prepared with the pertinent insurance policy information for every member of your Unit.
- Non-Samoset Council Units should bring their own insurance information or proof of Council insurance.
