You should be in your scout shirt, scout pants or khaki colored pants, and a troop neckerchief. Please take the time to dress appropriately to make Troop 181 look honorable!

The ceremony starts at the LOG CABIN (west of the Fire Station) at 11:00 am. We need to arrange for flag carriers, pamphlets distributors, flag folders, and flower distributors in advance. Please ***be prepared*** in advance! **We need everyone to show great support!**

The parade will start in the street near the Log Cabin, following the opening ceremony, and proceed to the flagpole in Baumann Park. At the flagpole, there will be another ceremony to honor all veterans. Also, there will be a number of scouts needed to assist the girl scouts as they hand-out flowers for the ceremony on the river bank.

Following dismissal, scouts and their families are invited to our Cherry Valley United Methodist Church for soup and sandwiches. **Parents and siblings are invited to come for the remembrance ceremony, and/or the lunch.** (Please bring a donation for your lunch.) If you're not staying for the lunch, pick-up your scout 12:15-12:30 at the Fire Station parking lot, or at the church thereafter.
