The Troop is taking over a new fundraising opportunity this year. We will be staffing the concession stand for the Rockford Youth Baseball League at Talcott-Page Park near the intersection of Kilburn and School St.

We are asking families to sign up to cover 3-hour shifts on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday each week for a total of 9 weeks. We would like to have at least 1 scout and 2 parents for each shift or 2 scouts each with a parent. It will be your responsibility to take care of customers and do some light food preparation.

Each time you work a shift, your scout will be compensated in their scout account based on the total profit at the end of the season.

The menu will include items such as hot dogs, chips, popcorn, drinks, ice cream, and candy.

For your information:

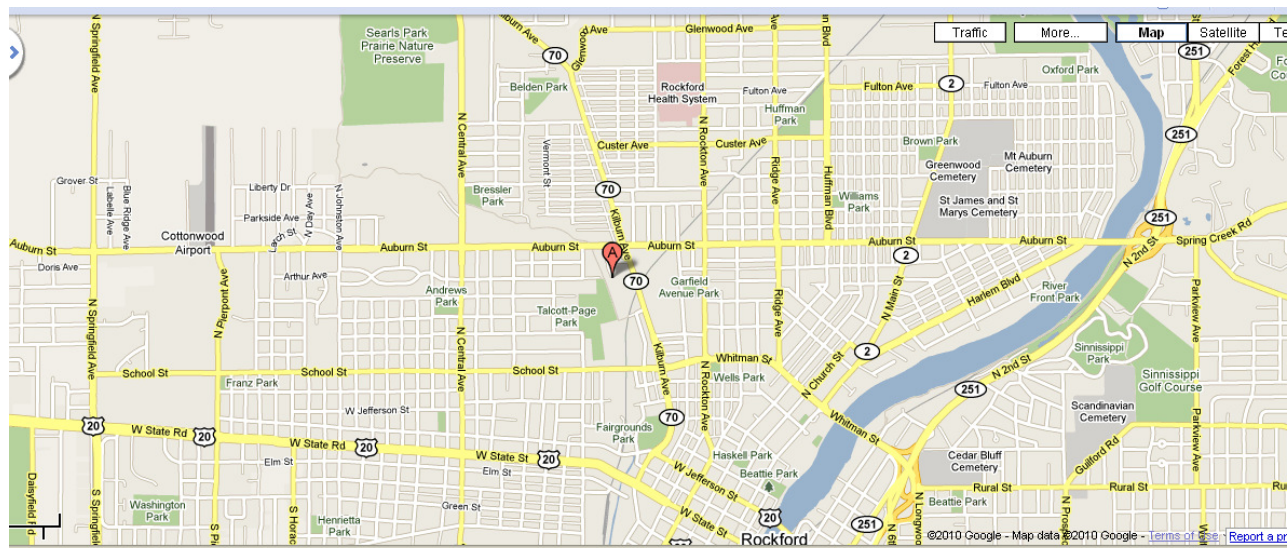
